What ProsPecT is/does

- ProsPecT is an **online form** to collect the description of your products
- And create a json file from that
- The json form can be sent to CAESAR Node2000
- Have a look at the [ProSpecT instructions document](#)
 - A live document.



Why we needed ProsPecT

- The json file will be used to create the metadata map
 - The metadata map is needed to complete the design of ASPIS prototype
 - We need a standard for the description of the various products
- A json file can describe a complex info structure and can be read and analysed in an «automated» way.

- But the json file is downloaded on your laptop/pc!
- NOTE: a finished/unfinished json file can be also uploaded into ProSpect. This can help you!
